

Gendai Reiki Master Referral Guidelines

The Master Referral section of the official Gendai Reiki Network website introduces Gendai Reiki master members who teach Gendai Reiki. Only master members who understand and comply with the International Common Standards for Gendai Reiki Masters established by Hiroshi Doi Sensei and the objectives and mission of the Gendai Reiki Network are listed.

Guidelines for listing in the Master Referral section

- (1) The latest official Gendai Reiki manual must be used in the seminars.
- (2) Online and distant seminars are strictly prohibited, except for the Introduction level. The Introduction level can be held online.
- (3) Making changes to Gendai Reiki attunements is strictly prohibited.
- (4) Gendai Reiki attunements, Gendai Reiki teachings, and Gendai Reiki techniques must not be taught to anyone other than seminar participants.
- (5) Symbols must not be shared with the public or with students who have not reached the appropriate level.
- (6) Gendai Reiki Masters must issue a certificate of the level completed and an energy lineage chart after the Gendai Reiki seminar.
- (7) Misleading statements that Gendai Reiki and Usui Reiki are different systems must be avoided. Do not use two titles, such as "Usui Reiki Master and Gendai Reiki Master."
- (8) Copying, altering, transferring, selling, viewing, or disclosing the official manuals to outside parties is strictly prohibited.

Precautions to be taken at the seminar

- (1) Seminars must be conducted in person. However, the Introduction may be provided online.
- (2) Seminars must be at least 6 hours long for each level.
- (3) Each level should be described as "Level 1 (or Shoden)", or "Level 2 (or Okuden)". "First Degree" and "Reiki 1" should not be used.
- (4) The title for those who have completed Level 4 should be consistent with Gendai Reiki Master. Do not use "Gendai Reiki Teacher."
- (5) If a student of another lineage of Reiki wishes to study Gendai Reiki, please have them start with Introduction/Level 1 instead of a continuation level. Even those who have learned Gendai Reiki from other Gendai Reiki Masters should retake the seminar from the Introduction/Level 1.

Notes on the website

- (1) The objective of the seminar is not just attunement. Avoid using the expression "We give you Reiki attunements."
- (2) The Gendai Reiki lineage should be correctly indicated as follows:
Usui Sensei - Taketomi Sensei - Koyama Sensei - Doi Sensei - XXX - YYY - you - your students
- (3) If you also teach another lineage of Reiki other than Gendai Reiki, please describe clearly the difference between the Gendai Reiki curriculum and other Reiki.
- (4) Please provide a link to the Gendai Reiki Network (GRN).

In case of violation

Failure to meet the above requirements will result in removal from the Master Referral section.
